As I do every year, I'd like to start with thanking all our committee members, coaches, umpires and everyone else who has volunteered their time during the 2024 winter season. In particular, I'd like to say a special thank-you to our Club Secretary, Sue Harvey, who is stepping down from the Committee this year after being an integral part of this Club for the last 12 years. On a personal level, Sue has been an incredible support to me since I joined the Committee and eventually took over as President. At the time of writing this, the grand-finals have not been played. 6 teams bowed out after semi-finals, including all of our 7/8 teams, and 3 teams lost their preliminary final, leaving us with an impressive 8 teams playing in the grand-final. Wishing each of those teams all the very best and hope to be holding up 8 flags at our wind-up.

Unfortunately, some teams had a tougher season. Don't be disheartened if your team didn't experience success this season — every single player has, or will, experience this over their netball journey. Hopefully you improved your skills and made some new friends. Next season is a whole new ball game.

Last year we decided to hold an all-teams wind-up rather than having separate ones for each competition. It was a resounding success and we will continue with the format this season. Leah and Siobhan have been busy finalising the preparations, no doubt it will a lot of fun. Hope to see you all there.

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ON 15TH SEPTEMBER 2024 WEST COASTERS NETBALL CLUB

Financial year: 1 October 2023 to 30 September 2024

As of the 13th of September 2024, the club's profit and loss statement reflects a net profit of **\$31,632.76**. While the financial year has not yet concluded, there are still some expected income and expenses to account for.

Estimated Upcoming Expenses:

AGM UMPIRE REPORT

The 2024 season was extremely successful for West Coasters on an umpiring front. The Club participated in the PNA Club Umpire Development Grants Program, which allowed us to assist the development of some of our junior umpires. This Program involved a group of six Umpire Mentors attending an Umpire Coaching Workshop at PNA, where they then spent time mentoring our Foundation Umpires each week.

West Coasters had approximately 40 regular umpires in the 2024 season. Communication with umpires was undertaken via a Whatsapp group chat.

Connections with PNA and the other Club Umpire Coordinators remains strong – through the Umpire Coordinators Facebook Group, I was able to share umpires & assist others in covering timeslots.

We had three umpires achieve their C Badge qualification this year: Miranda Rocavert, Vienna Overholt and Eva Davis.

We also had many umpires who begun with zero umpiring experience and saw great improvement in the confidence on court by the end of the season. I thank our umpire mentors Lauren Noack, Indi Letch-Avenell, Otia Wynyard-Thompson, Sarah Spencer and Ally Bowman for their help over the season.

I believe we have laid a strong development pathway for our upcoming umpires and will look forward to supporting many girls in achieving their C Badge in the 2024 season.
